Hills promotes safe cycling message at family cycling festival

Two heavy goods vehicles from the Hills Quarry Products fleet will be making an appearance at the Castle Combe Family Cycling Day on Sunday 30 August to promote the Mineral Products Association's (MPA) national Cycle Safe Campaign.

The campaign highlights the potential risk of cyclists undertaking lorries and getting too close to them at lefthand turns and roundabouts.
